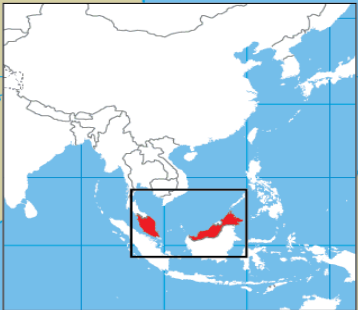

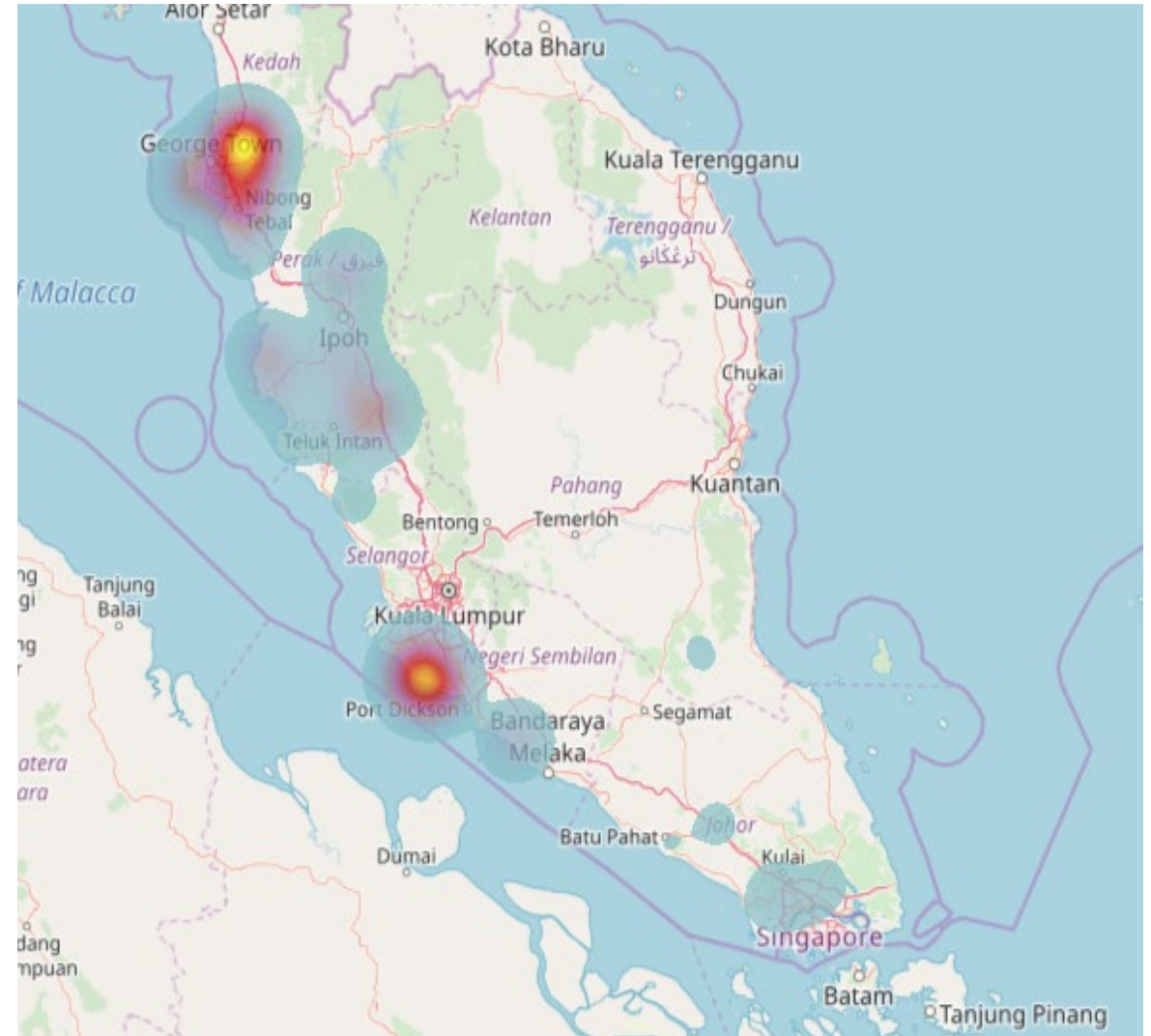

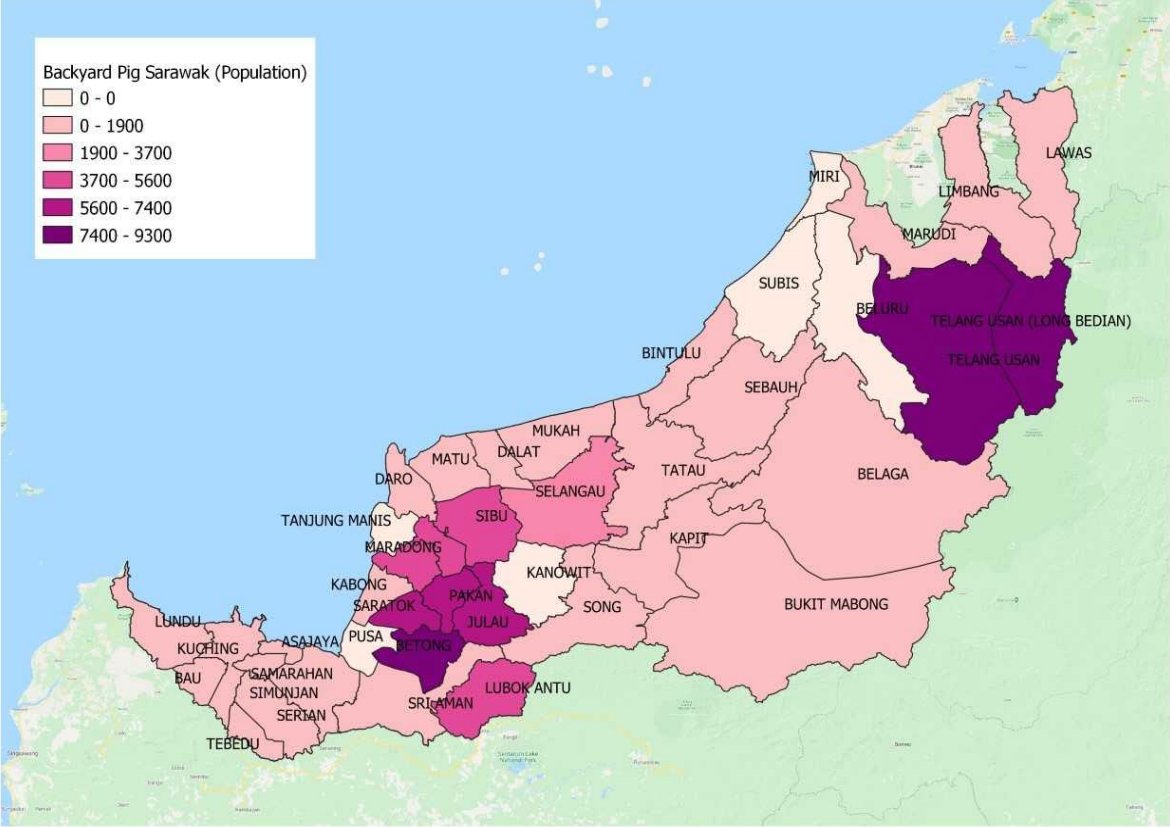
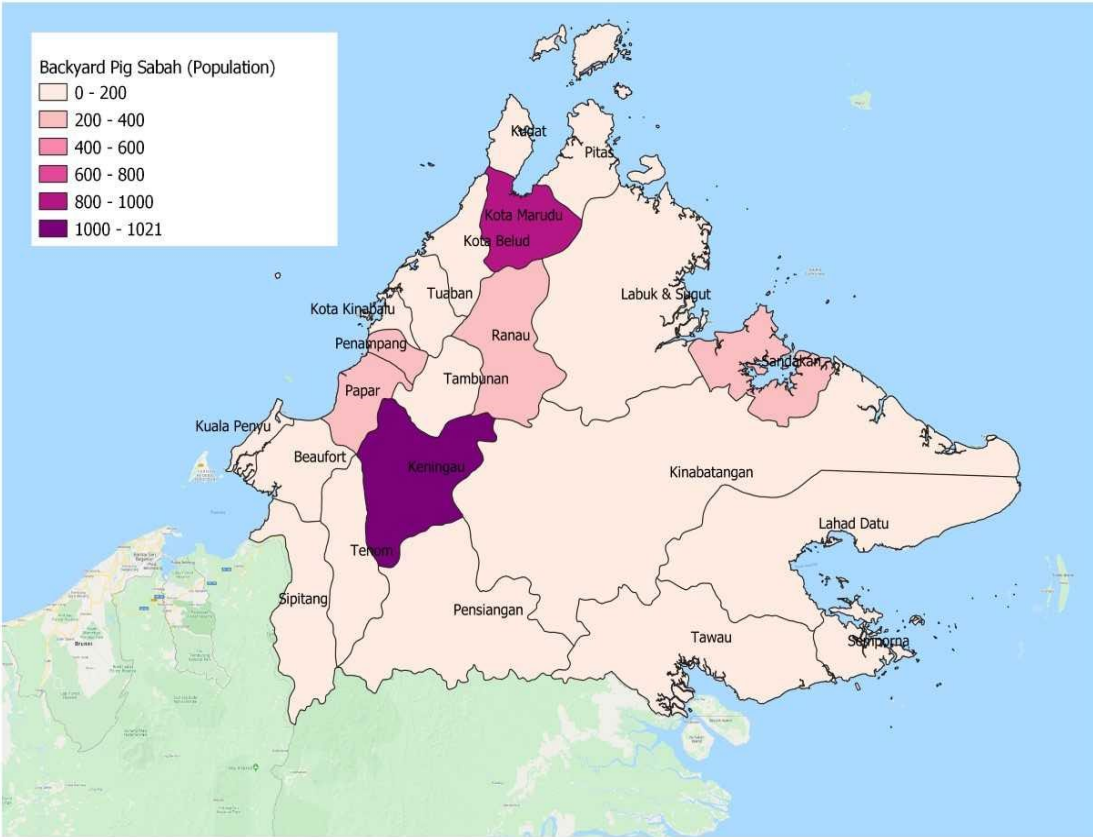
STATUS OF BACKYARD PIG FARMING AND DISTRIBUTION

ASF CONTINGENCY/PREPAREDNESS PLAN

1. **RISK ANALYSIS** - threats might arise from importation
2. **PREVENTION STRATEGIES** - quarantine policy, swill feeding control etc
3. **EARLY WARNING** - surveillance, training, awareness program, special diagnostic team, laboratory capabilities
4. **EARLY REACTION, CONTAINMENT AND ERADICATION** - SOP
5. **ORGANIZATIONAL ARRANGEMENTS DURING AN EMERGENCY CAMPAIGN** - responsibilities and command structure
6. **SUPPORT PLANS** - financial support, resources, legislation
7. **ACTION PLAN** - Investigation, alert and operational phase
