- Animal Science Division of ICAR under the DARE, GoI: An important wing of National Agricultural Research System of India
- Conducts, coordinates and monitors research activities in 19 Research Institutes (including 2 Deemed Universities) with around 1000 scientific positions supported by trained technical staff.
- Also coordinates 7 All India Coordinated Research Projects, 6 Network Research Programmes, 4 Outreach Programmes and 3 Mega Seed Projects (poultry, sheep and pig) in different parts of the country.
- Coordination and collaboration with research institutes, commercial establishments and NGOs for development and transfer of technologies- Inked 233 MoUs (10 years)
- Krishi Vigyan Kendra (KVKs)-Farm Science Centre- 721 with farmers outreach
